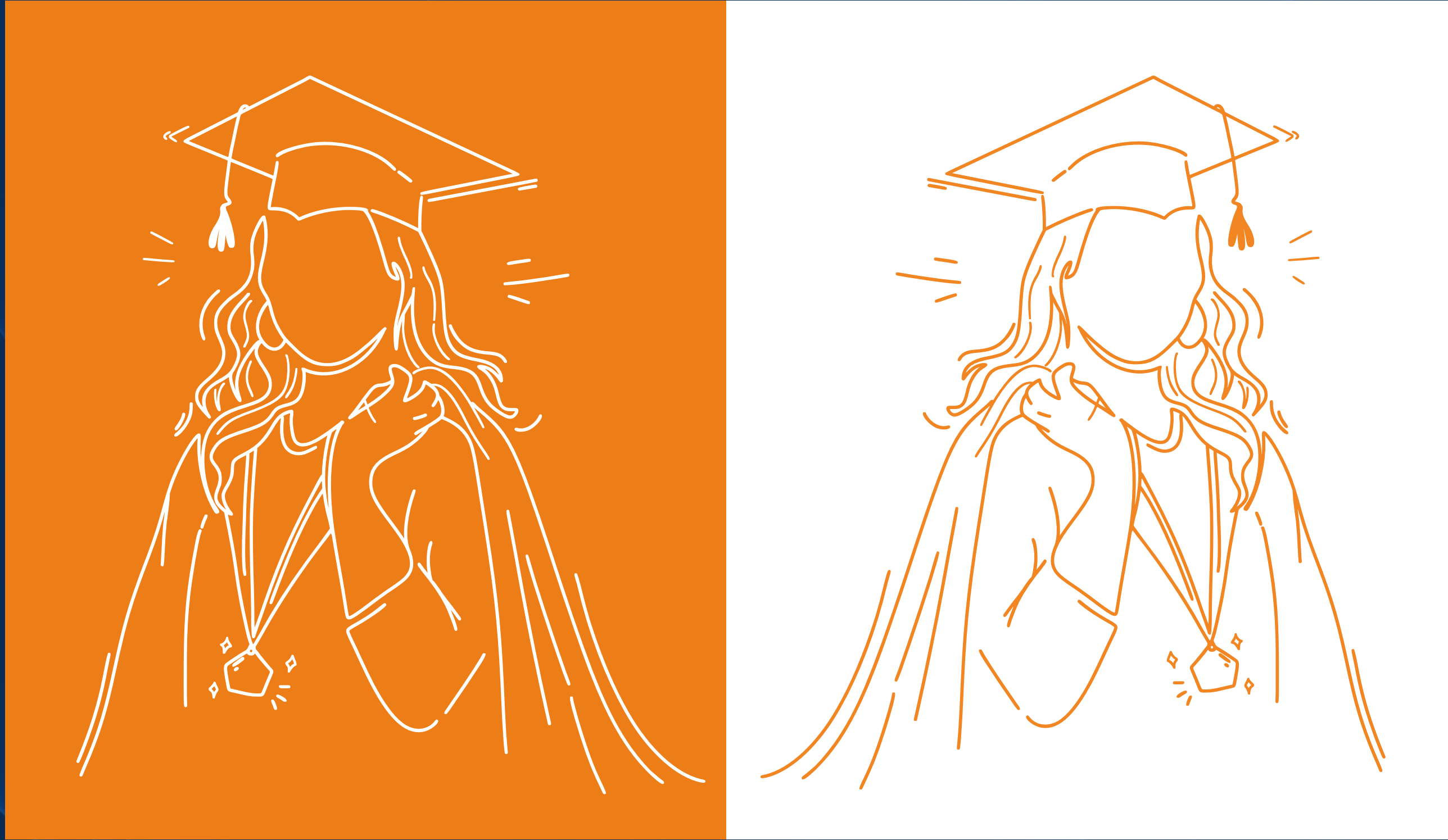

Five Years of Experience and Iterative Growth



Literature-Supported User Preference

Most applicants and PDs prefer [CentralApp] over ERAS. These data, in conjunction with the cost savings, suggest that [CentralApp] may be a better alternative for the integrated plastic surgery match

In comparison to ERAS, [CentralApp] was reported to be more intuitive and concise.

Ultimately, [CentralApp] represents a great step for specialties to have more control over their application and selection process as well as allowing for the implementation of specialty-specific information

Overall: This was a great pilot for what should be the norm in the residency application process

[CentralApp] would likely alleviate some of the socioeconomic barriers some med students face during the application process

What is the cost to our applicants and programs this cycle?

Model A: Exclusive Use

- Thoracic Surgery applicants apply only using TSCA
- Applicants pay a flat fee of \$249 to apply to any TS program
- Zero cost to TSDA to build with CentralApp
- Signaling centralized within CentralApp

Model B: Trial Use

- Thoracic Surgery applicants apply using both TSCA and ERAS for a side-by-side comparison
- Applicants pay nothing to CentralApp
 - \$25K fee to TSDA to support TSCA build and platform maintenance



How does a separate application process impact The Match? The SOAP?

- The residency application process is completely separate from The Match
- We work closely with the NRMP and are building an API to enhance data -sharing to support the SOAP
- Dual -applicants should be advised to complete ERAS as well



Is CentralApp supported by the FMSB/NBME?

Yes! We have had a relationship with the FSMB/NBME as well as the NBOME to provide full USMLE/NBOME transcripts. This year, that API is being enhanced to provide direct integration.
